DOT Hazardous Material Transportation Training

Introduction

In compliance with the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) regulations, this training is for individuals who handle, manage, transport, or ship hazardous materials / waste. This course is intended for individuals who manage hazardous materials in their job. This includes employees who load, unload, and handle hazardous materials; select, mark, label, or modify containers or packaging; prepare materials for shipping; prepare shipping papers; are responsible for the safety of hazardous materials during shipment; and operate vehicles.

A regulatory requirement is that this training be taken once every 3 years. The training course can be taken on-line while complying with the DOT regulations. DOT regulations require that an instructor have the minimum education and or experience with hazardous materials to teach this course. This course has been approved by the American Board of Industrial Hygiene.

Training Objectives

- Locate and use the Federal hazardous materials regulations.
- Properly label and mark hazardous material containers for shipment.
- Complete shipping papers for hazardous materials.
- Select proper packaging for hazardous materials.
