## Electrical Safety Training (29 CFR 1926.400)

### Introduction

In compliance with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) 29 CFR 1926.400 Subpart K regulations, this training is required for construction workers who may use extension cords, electric tools, etc. This course is also eligible for .08 Continuance of Certification (COC) points from the Board of Certified Safety Professionals. This course provides an overview of basic electrical safety for construction workers with little or limited training or familiarity with electrical hazards.

While this training course is very comprehensive, we highly recommend that additional site-specific training be taken for certain hazardous materials that may be encountered at different sites.
